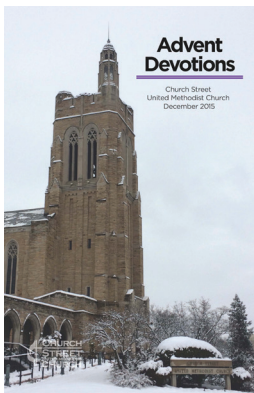
H.A.B.I.T.
